Policy Document on Institutional Free ships

Gonna Institute of Information Technology and Sciences has always been driven by the vision of Sri G.B.Naidu, Chairman who believes in rewarding outstanding achievements to the next generation of leadership for organizations, communities and society at large. Scholarships are a form of financial aid that are often awarded to students to help cover the cost of their education. These scholarships can be in the form of grants, which do not need to be repaid, effectively making them a "free ship" for students in terms of financial assistance.

The institutional in-house Free ships are for the students studying in Under Graduate and Post Graduate course. Many scholarship programs are designed to support female students, SC, ST other backward classes (OBC) and EWS in their pursuit of education. These scholarships may be based on academic performance, financial need, or specific criteria, such as girls pursuing STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) fields.

PREREQUISITE FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Basic eligibility was considered at the time of joining in to 1st year i.e. for Post Graduate program the basic eligibility was any UG.
- 1. Girl Students their academic percentile >= 55%
- 2. SC & ST Students their academic percentile >=45%
- 3. OBC students their academic percentile >55%
- 4. EWS their academic percentile >=60%
- B. Based on academic performance
 Students who are from financially weaker section and have performed well in the examinations shall be eligible for scholarship. Those who have score above 90% (or)9.0
 GPA in their final exam to become eligible under scholarship policy. The yearly income of the parents from all resources should be less than Rs. 1,50,000/-

SPONSORSHIP POLICY

The Department Advisory committee and the Examination cell in coordination after the announcement of the result will prepare a merit list of students likely to be eligible for scholarship within five weeks after the announcement of the results.

OBJECTIVES OF THE POLICY

To encourage young women students, SC, ST, OBC and EWS who do not receive any financial assistance from government/NGO schemes.

AUTHORITY TO REVISION IN THE POLICY

The management of GIITS reserves the authority to modify or amend the policy. Such amendments shall come into force from the date of issue of such amendments.
