The National Service Scheme is efficiently overseen by the college, and through departments, the institution administers a variety of community engagement projects.

Extension activities are prominently showcased through various channels, effectively conveying the rich experiences of both staff and students, as well as research discoveries. The Institute takes pride in hosting a diverse array of regional and national level workshops, seminars, conferences, and symposia, spanning a wide spectrum of subjects.
